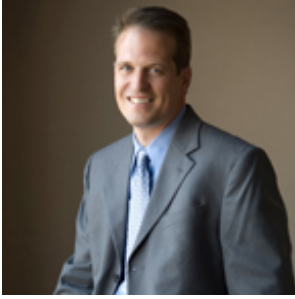


Scott Socha, Vice President - Treasurer
